1708 Gallery has invited some of the region's most prominent and new artists to exhibit their small works, which will be available to the public as a silent auction. The exhibition will close with a silent auction gala on December 19th determining who will take home some of the region's most sought after works of art.

New this year - a show within the show: *Art Box* - featuring six limited-edition art works created by Paul Teeples, Tom Chenoweth, Carole Garmon, Robert Walz, Rob Tarbell, and Cindy Neuschwander. These artists were each provided with a 10" x 10" gift box to alter in some way, minimally or completely, creating an exciting, new, one of a kind art-piece.
